To the Rules of Student Mobility Programmes under Student Exchange Agreements signed by Collegium Civitas

Qualifying criteria:

- GPA (grade point average) for the last completed semester of study (0-5 pts):

Grading scale:

- ✓ 0 pts - <4.00
- ✓ 1 pts- 4.00 - 4.24
- ✓ 2 pts - 4.25 - 4.49
- ✓ 3 pts - 4.5 - 4.74
- ✓ 4 pts - 4.75 - 4.99
- ✓ 5 pts - > 4.99

- Proof of knowledge of a foreign language (0-2 pts):

Grading scale:

- ✓ 0 pts - no proof of knowledge of the English language or a lack of knowledge of this language;
- ✓ 1 pts - certificate issued by a foreign languages school;
- ✓ 2 pts - a certificate of knowledge of a foreign language recognised by Collegium Civitas in the process of admission to first or second cycle study programmes or being a native speaker (confirmed citizenship of one of the countries where English is the official language).

- Social activities for the university and outside the university (0-3 pts):

Grading scale:

- ✓ 1 pts – interesting activity outside CC;
- ✓ 2 pts - one-time activity for the benefit of CC (e.g. taking part in fairs);
- ✓ 3 pts - long-term activity for the benefit of CC (e.g. taking part in research groups).

- Motivation to study abroad (0-2 pts):

Grading scale:

- ✓ 0 pts - lack of motivation;
- ✓ 1 pts - partial motivation;
- ✓ 2 pts - strong motivation to take part in the mobility as demonstrated in the student's motivation letter;

- In the case of study programmes co-financed by the EU: the consent for study abroad signed by the supervisor of the respective specialization.

All components are assessed jointly. A student must obtain a minimum of 4 points with at least 1 point for the knowledge of a foreign language in order to qualify for a mobility programme. If more candidates obtain the same number of points the decision will be made on a first-come, first-served basis.

Each decision of the Commission can be appealed against to the Rector of CC within 14 days from the receipt of the decision.
