II. PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN WARSAW

Warsaw has an efficient public transport service, which is run by ZTM (Public Transport Authority). You can travel fast and easily by bus, tram and metro (2 lines: M1 and M2). Collegium Civitas is located in the very centre of Warsaw, at the Palace of Culture and Science (Plac Defilad 1). There are convenient public transport connections to Collegium Civitas from anywhere in the city.



Public transport tickets

- Tickets can be bought from ticket machines (at stops), in kiosks and in some trams, buses and metro stations. With the student fare, a 20-minute ticket costs 1.7 PLN. Please make sure you have valid student ID card with you
- The best deal is to purchase a Warsaw City Card, i.e. long-term tickets. 30-day or 90-day ones. For detailed information, please visit the website: www.wtp.waw.pl
- Use the www.jakdojade.pl application! It is a travel planner application that takes into account all means of public transport in the city

You can use alternative travel options to get to our university or to other places.



In Warsaw, there is a very well developed system of city bike rentals, available from March to November. You can register online. The first 20 minutes of driving are always free. Detailed information on the website: www.veturilo.waw.pl.

A fast ride around Warsaw is guaranteed by electric scooters, offered for example by companies such as: Blinkee, Bolt, Dott, Lime, Tier. To use them, you need to download the application to your phone, register an account and connect the card from which the money is directly withdrawn.

Virtual University (VU) is a system which provides student services online. It contains information on study programmes, class schedules, lecturers' duty hours, financial account balance with the number of an individual account to which tuition fees should be paid, as well as other information. Via the Virtual University, you can submit a student application, enrol for classes, check your grades for course components, grades from exams and your grade average.

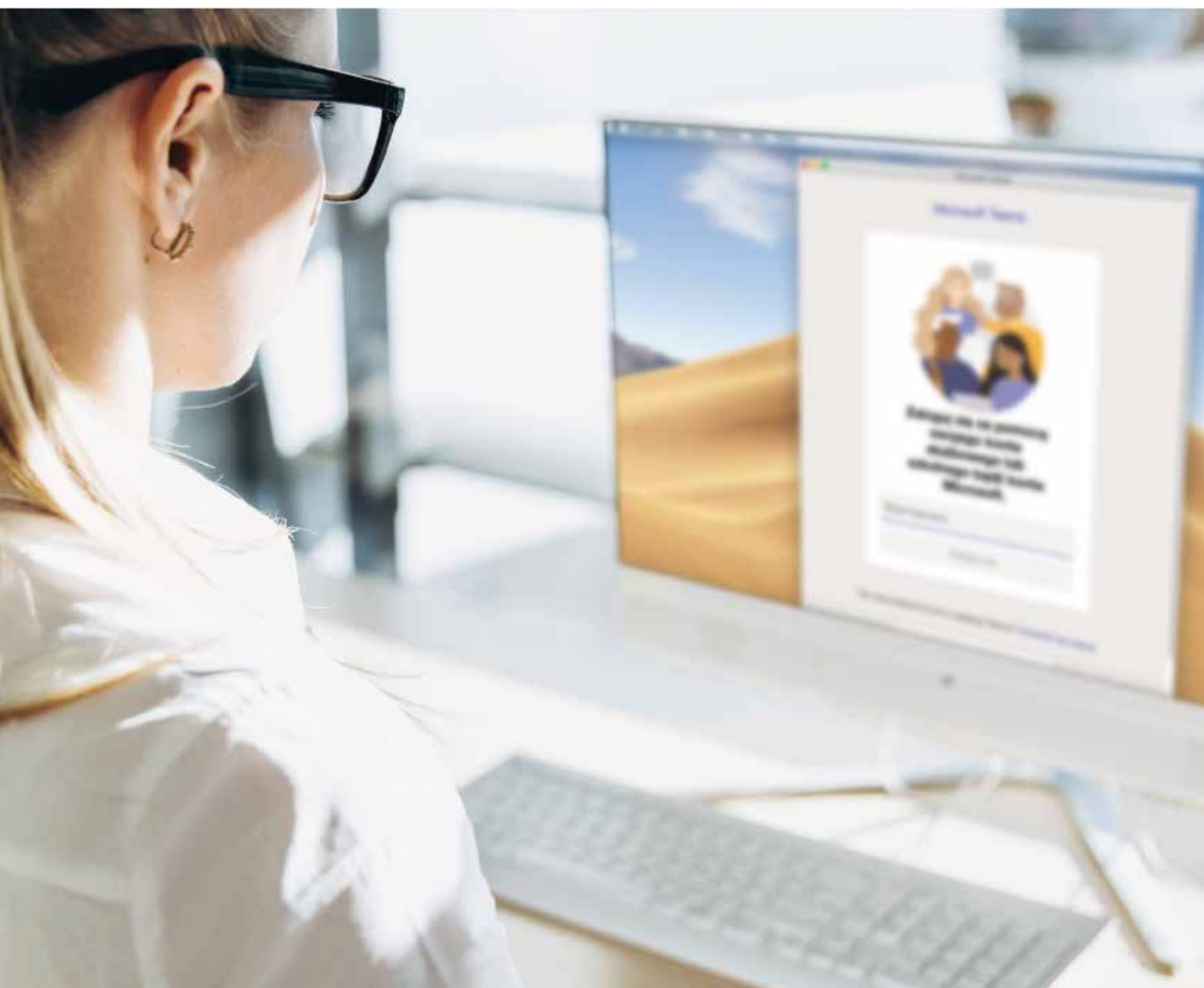

General rules on how to use computer rooms:

- you have access to two rooms with computer stations
- in each room, there is a limit of persons present at one time
- the rooms are open: Monday-Friday 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. and during session weekends from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

- reserve computer stations through the queue system at least a few days in advance, by providing the surname of the reserving person, contact telephone number, date and time of start and finish of work on the computer
- have your own headphones (with mini-Jack or USB port)
- you can remain on the premises of the University for the amount of time of your previously arranged reservation of the computer station
- when on the premises of the University and using computer stations, observe the rules of health and safety applicable during the pandemic at CC and in the Palace of Culture and Science
- if you are using electronic equipment, disinfect your hands and the work station both before and after using the infrastructure of the University
- when the computer station reservation time expires, leave the computer room

General rules for access to the library:

- before you borrow for the first time, apply for a library account;
- readers may borrow a maximum of 3 books to take home at a time for a period of 21 days;
- a student ID card or other document with a photo is required to make a borrowing request;
- a useful feature is the reservation of books through the online catalog (note – a necessary condition is the simultaneous reservation of an appointment in the library at <https://civitas.nakiedy.pl/>).

The Collegium Civitas library is a friendly place where you can find:

- a rich collection of teaching materials for classes available in the reading room and via Library OneDrive;
- electronic subscriptions of news magazines;
- Academica terminal with more than 3.5 million books and magazines in digital format;
- access to scientific databases such as EBSCO and JSTOR.

ACTIVE STUDENTS ARE THE ONES WHO AS PART OF THEIR STUDENT ORGANIZATION:

- organise events: meetings with interesting people, lectures, conferences, events related to the celebration of various holidays, such as Christmas Eve, Easter;
- run social media accounts of their scientific clubs, produce podcasts, write texts or create photos and videos;
- help organise Adaptation Days, Cultural Days, take part in the Buddy programme at CC; cooperate with different Divisions in the scope of promotion of the University (taking part in a promotional video or a photoshoot), or assist students from the Erasmus+programme)



The amount of the discount is awarded based on the activity of a given student and may reach up to 30% if the student has taken part in multiple.

The discounts are awarded in each semester of the academic year. Please keep an eye out for a message containing the crucial dates and information sent to your students e-mail address.

Collegium Civitas is at the forefront of the most internationalized non-public universities in Poland. Our university participates in the Erasmus+ programme and has a wide network of partner universities from abroad, not only from EU countries, for example: Australia, Indonesia, Japan, Canada, Kenya, Colombia, South Korea, Mexico, USA, and Vietnam).

How to get a scholarship?

To receive a scholarship you need to:

- submit application documents (access in the Virtual University / Wirtualna Uczelnia system after logging in);
- complete at least the first semester of studies at CC;
- know the language in which the exchange will take place at least at a communicative level.
- To earn extra points, it is also worth mentioning your activities in student organizations or other interesting activities outside of CC (important: activities must be documented) and remember to provide a motivation for your willingness to participate in the program.

Remember!

- You can find the full list of partner universities and the exchange regulations in the Virtual University, under "Useful information" → "Cooperation abroad".
- A semester or year completed abroad will be included in your curriculum (including subjects, grades, ECTS credits) and will be fully recognized by Collegium Civitas;
- As part of the program, you can also go on an internship abroad - to a company or other institution. This way, you can be credited for the mandatory internship at CC (applies to undergraduate studies). Internships can last from 2 to 12 months. Graduates also have this opportunity (the condition is to apply before the date of defense). The internship must begin and end within 12 months of graduation (defense).

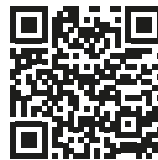
